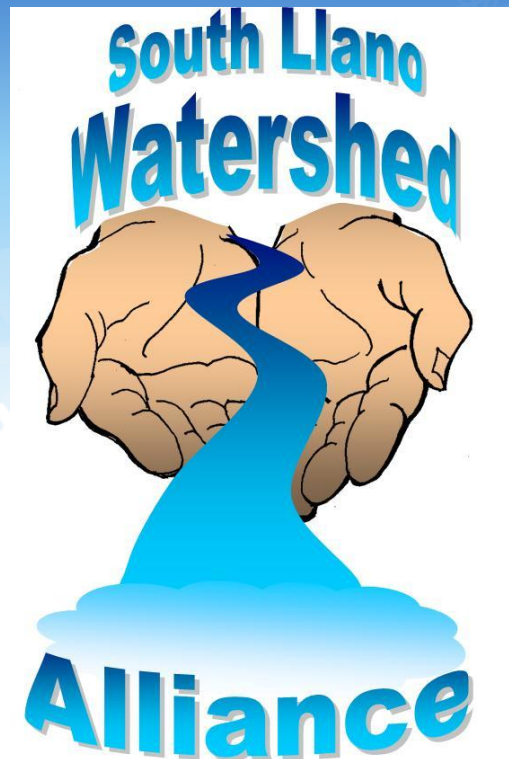

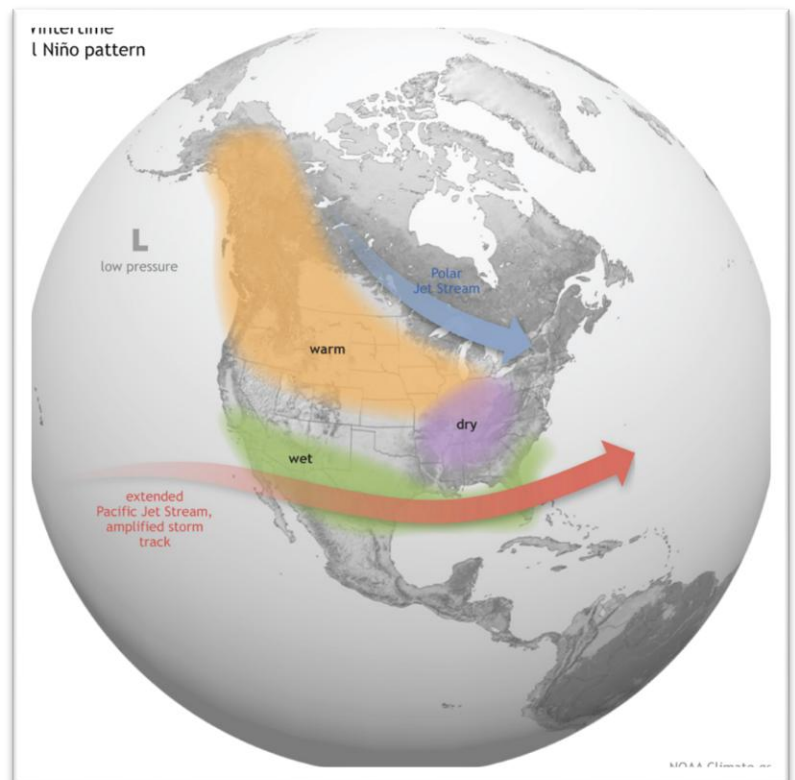

Flows of the Llano

The LCRA calculated that 2014 was [the 2nd lowest period of inflow](#) into the Highland Lakes.

In 2014, the flows of the **Llano River at Llano** contributed about 29% of the annual inflow to the Highland Lakes. The highest flow occurred May 27 (3,600 cfs) and the lowest flow was 6.7 cfs on August 13th
