- 3. Approval of Minutes—Gary motions, Holly second...Pass by consensus
- 4. New Business—
 - -Art Mudge makes motion to appoint Koy Coffer (new hire at TTU Outdoor School) as new director to board. Holly second. Pass unanimously.
 - -Tyson mentions that our membership with River Network has expired. Feel that has not been worth the fee. Will not renew...
 - -Emily mentions an accident of an 18 wheeler on I-10 eastbound near US 377. TCEQ came as fuel spilled.
 - -Znobia had conversation w/ Cody Plumley. He bought property on other side of ditch from Pilot. He has original agreement w/ TxDOT re ditch that is to be for IH-10 drainage only
- 5. Treasurer's Report: \$7,338.38...
- 6. Membership Report...Koy Coffer

- 7. Membership Drive...Goal to have each board member find 4 new members...Tyson will add membership form to mail out for stream restoration since Alliance will be a sponsor. (see item 13)
- 8. Status Report Upper Llano River Watershed Protection Plan & Meeting May 12th . Tyson mentioned that with approval at May 12th meeting WPP will go out for public comment
- 9. TPWD State Wildlife Grant-item tabled
- 10. Report on Spring Outing to Kerr WMA-- April 30...26 people attended the event. Felt it was a good turnout.
- 11. Preliminary Discussion of next outing...suggested to combine outing with River Festival at State Park (see item 18). Should also include Hill Country Alliance's Water 101 presentation at this event.
- 12. Wild & Scenic Film Fest w/ HCA- HCA got grant to have this festival. Emily has had preliminary discussions w/ HCA re opportunities... JD will talk with folks at the Odeon Theater in Mason re a possible venue.
- 13. Stream bank Restoration Workshop June 3 at TTU-Alliance agrees to donate lunch for workshop. Expecting 50 people at \$8/person. Tyson will also contact various Soil Boards for sponsors as well. RSVPs request will be May 30th.
- 14. Feedback on Landowner Guide Distribution-Art reports that he has distributed books to 4 realtors. One realtor (Bierschwale) wants more.
- 15. Texas Stream Team Efforts & Sampling Kit purchases Tyson will be purchasing 2 Core Kits and 2 Advanced kits next week. The cost will be about \$1,200. \$600 has been funded by Mason Community Development
- 16. "Don't Dump to River" Medallions Tyson checked on cost of medallions. They are \$600 for 100. The feeling from the Board is that they might be hard to see and signs may be a better alternative.

- 17. New topic: Possibility of having River History as a topic at the new Museum-item tabled. Znobia is still trying to contact Charles Hagood re this possibility.
- 18. New topic: River Festival with State Park Holly is suggesting a date of September 10th at the Park. A scaled down Outdoor Expo. Alliance can cover insurance component of kayaking events. This will be part of the Alliance's Fall Outing. A subcommittee of Holly, Koy and Tom was formed to put this event together.
- 19. Next Board Meeting will be June 9th at Paddlers Porch-items for next meeting will include Alliance/Paddler's Porch koozies. Also a workshop targeted at realtors and elected officials.
